According to their website, "Canine Companions is leading the service dog industry so our clients and their dogs can live with greater independence. We provide service dogs to adults, children and veterans with disabilities and facility dogs to professionals working in healthcare, criminal justice and educational settings. Since our founding in 1975, our dogs and all follow-up services are provided at no cost to our clients." At the January BCREA meeting, Puppy Trainer Willy Estaban provided further statistics: Since 1975, nearly 8,000 dogs have been placed with



children, adults and veterans with varying disabilities. These dogs must be trained beginning at 8 weeks of age. There are 1300 puppy raisers and 4700 volunteers helping to do this. It costs \$60.000 -

\$100,000 to fully train a dog, but there is no cost to the client. Some don't make the

grade - they bark or they bite and can't be trained







This February is just around the corner. Groundhog Day and Valentine's Day are just ahead.







