An article entitled "Warning! I Was Scammed" in our BCREA March Newsletter, written by Bev Hoppe, was read by Anne Fagan, FREA Executive Director. Anne in turn, in her newsletter, addressed what we should do to protect ourselves from the scammers by not answering calls from unknown numbers, watching emails with misspelling, clicking on links, etc. Anne suggested a website to further help keep us safe in the cyber

world, https:// cyberguy.com. "Kurt the Cyber Guy" has been around for years giving us tips and tricks for our phones, computers and tablets. His website and free newsletter gives many suggestions to avoid cyber attacks.

Since 1992, April has been observed as National Stress Awareness Month and the first Wednesday in April is National Walking Day. Walking has been ranked as the most popular form of exercise. Research has shown that walking at a lively pace, at least 150 minutes a week, can help you think, feel and sleep better, improve memory and blood pressure and boost bone strength. When


